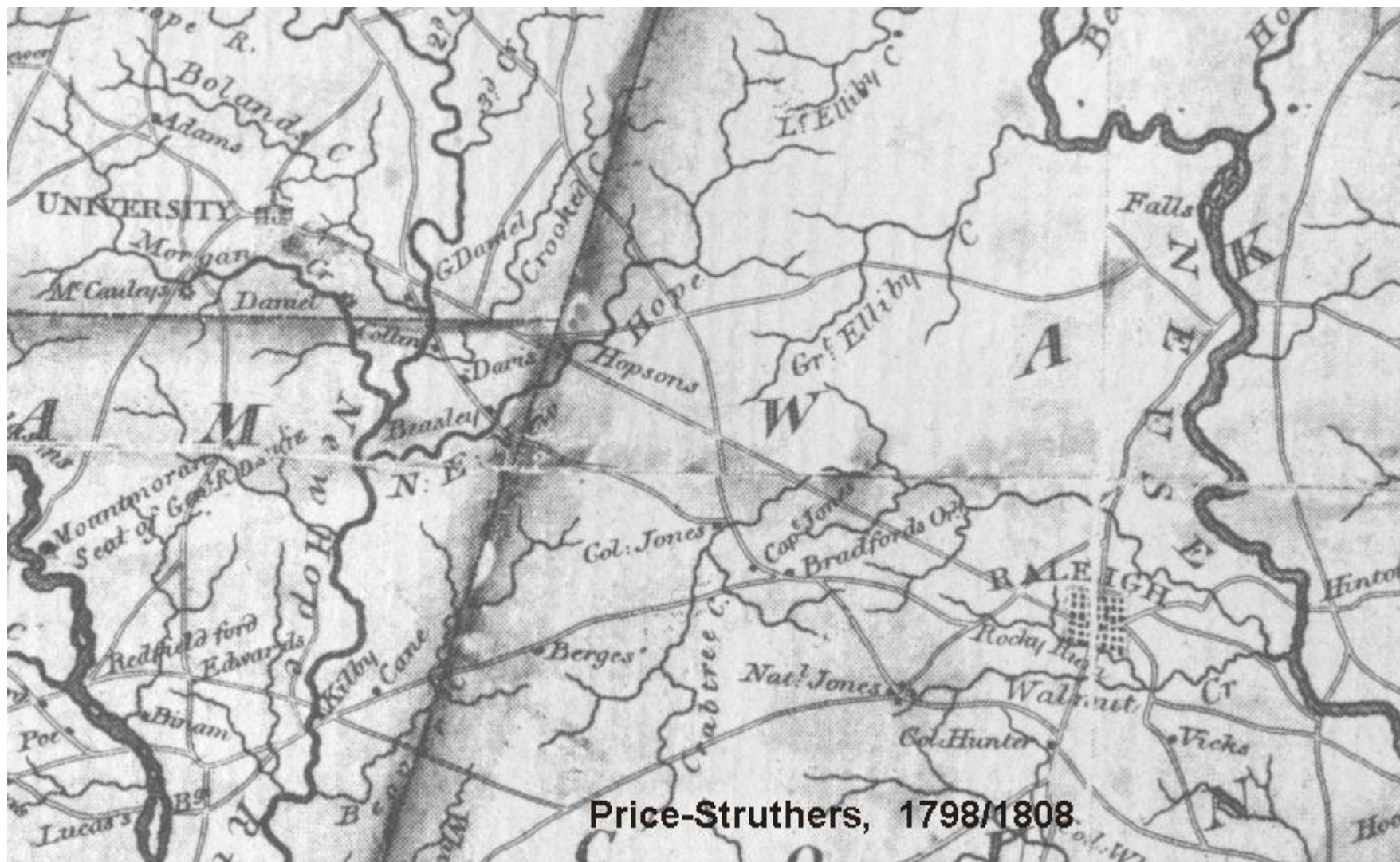
Travel in pre-modern times

Premodern Travel

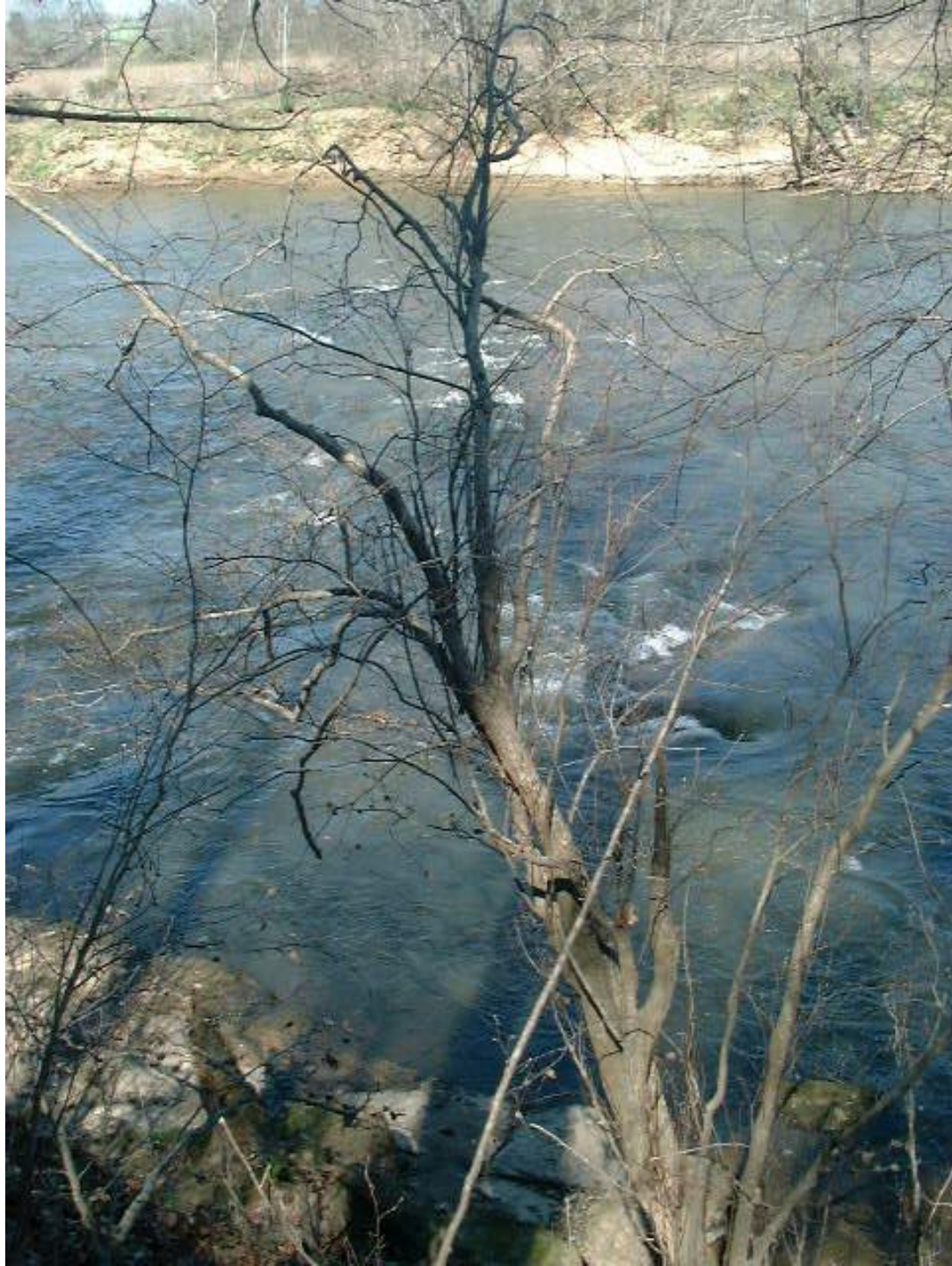
- Muscle Powered

No Markets: They subsisted











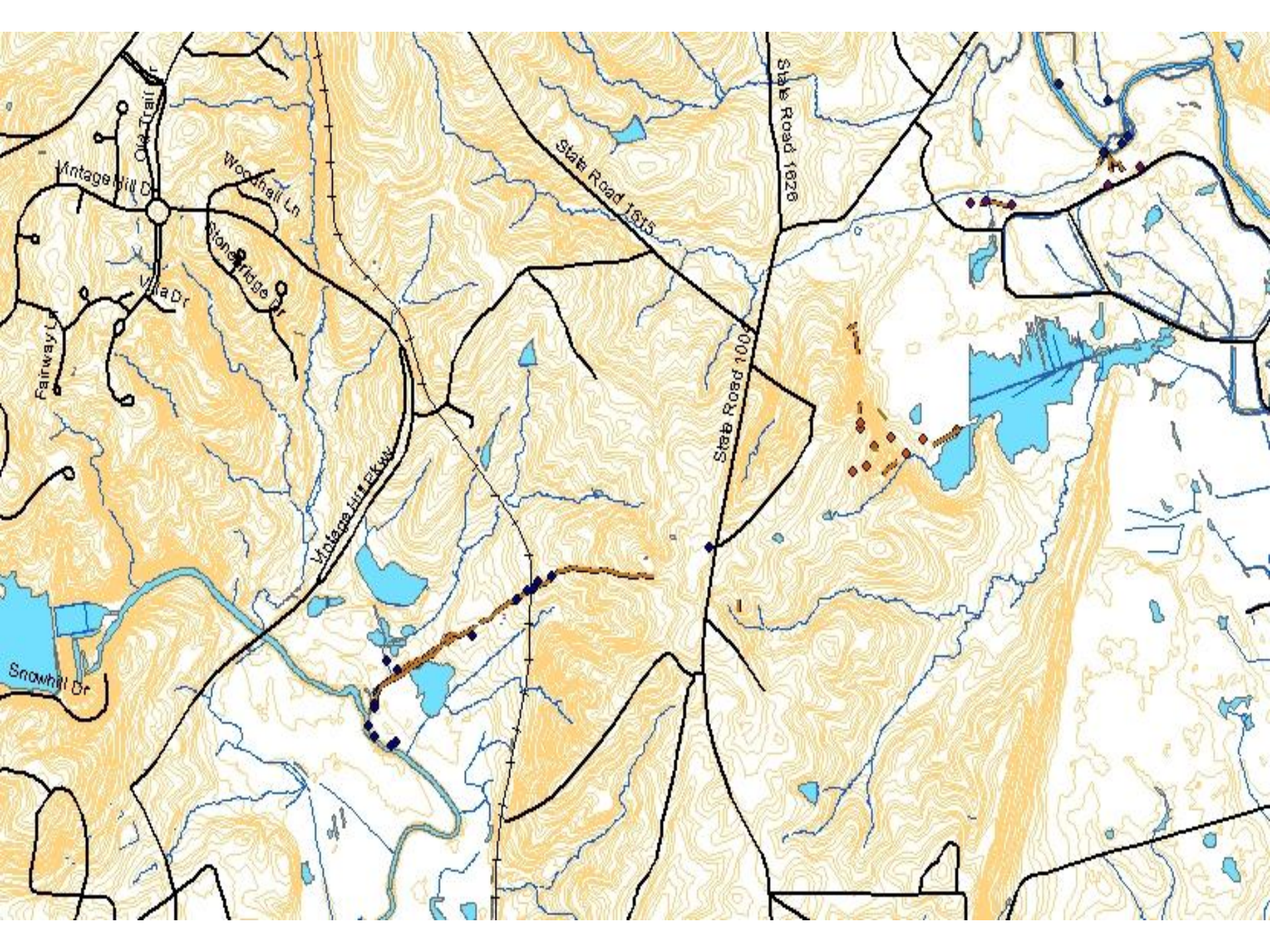
